**3.4 Late Notification of Intention to Open a School or Additional Year Levels**

The Board decided that schools/applicants which give late notification of their intention to open new schools or additional year levels should be advised that they have not met the RSB's requirements for Approval to Open/registration.

Alia College (1981), St Andrews Christian College (1871) and Gilson College (1742) are three such schools that have given late notification regarding additional year levels in 2001.

These schools will be advised in writing of the six-month notification requirement and that Approval to Open and registration will be effected six months after the receipt of their letter of notification, at the earliest.

### 3.5 Stotts Colleges

The Manager reported that RSB Field Officer, Mr Ian McLiesh had advised that the proposed building for the new school which is located in Carlton, is satisfactory. The Manager recommended that the Board should proceed with the application for Approval to Open the school in 2001.

### 3.6 Haileybury College (1191)
