Information regarding HMAS *Leeuwin* discharge for the Royal Commission

Summary of Discharges

The following summary was extracted from historical records in relation to HMAS *Leeuwin* and covers all intakes of recruits trained at HMAS *Leeuwin* between January 1960 and December 1984 with the exception of the 18th intake (2 Jan 1967 – 6 Dec 1967) as no records could be located.

It should be noted that these numbers do not include the two intakes of Junior Recruits who were trained at HMAS *Cerberus* (17 Mar 1963 to 1 Mar 1965).

The total number of Junior Recruits who entered the Royal Australian Navy via HMAS *Leeuwin* is 12, 675, the total number discharged from HMAS *Leeuwin* is 1, 543.

These numbers do not include Junior Recruits who were selected as Officer Candidates or for posting to HMAS *Nirimba* as apprentices.
