Advice to LAC (AAFC) Adams of NSW Police Reporting

This afternoon OC 3 WG has informed LAC (AAFC) Adams by phone that complaints against him for inappropriate sexual relationships with three female cadets have been passed to the NSW Police for investigation. The phone conversation was done with LAC (AAFC) Adams in T/CO 381 Office T/CO 381 and the squadron WOFF present on a landline (not speaker phone).

OC 3 WG reports that LAC(AAFC) Adams was deflated and withdrawn during the phone call. LAC (AAFC) Adams asked who had made the complaints - *not able to say*, where were these events are alleged to have occurred - *RAAF Wagga and RAAF Williamstown*, who was the poc in NSW Police - *unable to answer as investigator not nominated*. LAC (AAFC) Adams also expressed concern that the AAFC support person CO 308 SQN FLTLT (AAFC) Casey had been withdrawn as a support. OC 3 WG explained that this was because FLTLT (AAFC) Casey was now required to provide support to cadets in this matter, and that support for LAC (AAFC) Adams had now been arranged through the ADF and through SQNLDR (AAFC) Banfield.

T/CO 381 is also going to provide feedback about the subsequent discussions after the phone call.

Telecon to NSW Police

OC 3 WG has made a phone report to NSW Police about the third complaint, and has requested that NSW Police increase the priority of the investigation.

Appointment of LAC (AAFC) Adams

For information, LAC (AAFC) Adams was appointed to the AAFC as an AAFC staff member on 1 July 2012. Before that time he was involved in the AAFC as an Auxiliary staff member. The three allegations with the NSW Police appear to be after LAC (AAFC) Adams was appointed as an AAFC staff member. If any allegations surface which are alleged to have occurred before 1 July 2012, the matter would likely become a Service offence.
