If we cannot stop cadets gossiping that is fair enough, but staff members should not form part of that gossip and we should know better than to gossip about such a serious incident. Staff should be able to be controlled, as we are the adults in this organisation. As a Permanent Air Force Member and a SQN CO I would have expected better of him, but his behaviour has been unacceptable in this instance.

There is need for concern about his behaviour at the next Wing activity, being the Wing Comps and Ball.

Please advise what steps will be taken and when, so I can ease CWOFF^{CJE}'s concerns about WOFF(AAFC) REDACTED continuing to gossip about her to his 'group' of CWOFF's etc that hang around him.
