My only expectation is that you will be truthful throughout the process, and I know you will be. The interview can be intimidating for anyone, but just try to relax (easy for me to say), consider your answer to the question by thinking the best way to respond in your mind before doing so. The purpose is to get as much detail as possible to conclude the investigation. While words such as interview and investigation are used, you are not the one under investigation, he is. All you are doing is telling the interviewer what happened.

Should you need any more information, support or reassurance you only need to email, text or call me, or CJF .

When I see you in 2 weeks it will just be a normal night with this behind you. While I will ask if you're OK, apart from CJF and I, no other 302 cadet or instructor will be told as it doesn't concern them.

Everything will be OK, there is nothing to fear and it will all go away soon enough.
