Sir,

As you are aware that there is an investigation going on, I feel unsure of how it is being dealt with on a few things.

First of all, the way the investigation is being handled, as I've been told when the interview will take place, not being asked when I am feel as as I'm a victim, should've the investigators ask when it is possible for me to have the interview, not them tell me? I have not been told who my primary or secondary investigator's are, but I take it that one of them is SQNLDR (AAFC) Sharon O'Donnell. I also feel like this investigation is informal as I've received a few phone calls asking questions over the phone, it may be due to efficiency but I am trying to take this investigation as serious as it is.

Last night, I called the SQNLDR (AAFC), as something popped up, she implied that I could only have one support person (can't

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entirely remember her exact words) and she clarified that my mother is my support person but I couldn't have anyone else, BUT my dad can come if he is free. I would feel more comfortable if I could have PLTOFF (AAFC)^{CJF} in the room as well as my mother for moral support, but PLTOFF (AAFC)^{CJF} is cadet policy support. Also last night, I got told that the dates may be changed and that an email will be sent out ASAP, these dates will then have been changed twice then, as if got moved the first time as my mother had to get my terminally ill grandmother from Newcastle, which it then go moved to Wednesday [19JUN13] but now will be most likely on this Friday [21JUN13] but has not been confirmed yet.

Another thing is, do you know what has happened? Do you know why this investigation is taking place? Because as you're my CO, I personally feel that you should know, I have not been instructed to tell or not to tell anyone.

What I'm trying to say is that I don't feel comfortable how this is being conducted, so I'm asking you for your advice as what I should do or if you could go up the chain of commander or if you could step in and help me on my behalf as I don't know if this is being dealt with correctly or if the way I'm being treated is acceptable.
