You will recall on 19 May 2015 I advised you that I had extended your funding for psychological support to 31 July 2015 to allow you an opportunity to provide any information you considered relevant to warrant a potential further extension of funding.

I have now considered this information and the circumstances of the decision to allow both yourself and ^{CJP} funding for psychological support at Commonwealth expense. It is now apparent to me that the decision, albeit well intentioned, was not appropriate and the psychological support at Commonwealth expense should have only been provided to your daughter ^{CJE}.

Funding for your support will therefore have to be discontinued; however I will extend funding to 31 October 2015 to afford support to you during the forthcoming Adams' trial in September and provide you sufficient time to finalise arrangements with your current provider if you choose. I note your desire to remain with your current health provider; however if you decide to change providers I can advise that NSW Health is a public health provider that you may wish to consider as an appropriate alternate option.

Please note this decision does not affect the availability of funding for support services to ^{CJE}. Funding for psychological support will remain available to her for the foreseeable future.

I sincerely hope the psychological support provided to you over the past two years has been of benefit to you, and I wish you well for the future.
