CJE was quite distraught last night, she divulged to me that she had been in receipt of a letter from 'Defence' stating that you were discontinuing funding support for her psych session post December 31 2015. This is in conflict with the letter dated 18th August 2015, where you stated her ongoing support "would be available for her for the foreseeable future".

Can you please advise where this decision has come from and what basis it was formed?

I finding it appalling to get conflicting communications from Defence. It has upset her very much.

Secondly, in your recent letter, which I fully appreciate, there is a note in there about "provision of a AAFC support person"....till this day I have NEVER had anyone try to contact

me to be a 'dedicated support person', and during the 'trial' I was very shocked and again disappointed, no one from AAFC nor Defence attended to be support for the victims. If you can ascertain who was meant to be the support person and find out when and who they contacted, I would be pleased.
