FUNDING FOR PSYCHOLOGICAL SUPPORT

Since July 2013, the Australian Air Force Cadets (AAFC) and Cadets Branch-Air Force (CB-AF) have offered you a variety of support mechanisms following the incident at RAAF Wagga. Support has included payment of psychological support, provision of an AAFC support person and a dedicated point of contact within CB-AF.

I understand the matter is now expected to conclude in December 2015. After extensive support and the sentencing pronouncement, I wish to advise that funding for your psychological support will cease effective 31 December 2015. I appreciate that this has been a traumatic and difficult period for you and believe Commonwealth support over this period has been appropriate whilst you were an AAFC cadet. However this support will cease on 31 December 2015.

I hope you have found this psychological support beneficial. Should you require further support, you may wish to contact NSW Health for alternative healthcare providers. In addition, you may be eligible for compensation under the Military and Rehabilitation Compensation Act. For further information, please refer to www.dva.gov.au
