Dear Terry

First of all, thank you thus far for the support provided by AAFC & ADF for the funding of my professional psychological support.

Secondly, I am only writing on behalf of myself, and I believe that CJE [REDACTED]'s paternal father has already communicated with your branch.

I also note, my daughter CJE [REDACTED] advised that Sean WATSON has also made contact with CJE [REDACTED] via an email last week, but is yet to speak with her.

I note in your last communication (email & letter dated 19th May 2015, you were extending financial support for myself and CJE's paternal father til July 31 2015 when you will be assessing the situation and making a decision for ongoing support.

I have been attending my Clinical Psychologist now since this whole 'nightmare' arose in May 2013 when I got that life changing call from 'Sharon O'Donnell' and uttered those words, any civil parent would never want to here! I must state it has been one avenue to assist me personally with the pain, anguish, emotional torment, and heart ache. I have been and still filled with rage, disgust, let down by the System, let down by peoples attitudes of not giving any care, and unequivocally let down by the integrity and stature of the Australian Defence Force allowing this 'scum' to commit such heinous crimes against young innocent ladies, who at the time in one shape or another were in the 'care' of AAFC and ADF.

The Trial has been set down for September 21 2015 at the Newcastle District Court for 7 days. I thought the leading months during the evidence gathering, and committals was enough, but the emotional torture, not only for myself, but also observing my own daughters emotions and ordeals etc has and is further torture. You have no idea how this has been – no idea!

What has further disgusted me, is the discontent and the discriminatory behaviour displayed by the Administration of the ADF/AAFC but not financing professional support for my husband **REDA** and step-father of CJE, who has been a primary carer now 15 years of her life – this is bluntly rude and unacceptable.

Not only have I had to deal with my own emotions and thoughts, but because my husband has been denied financial supported psychological assistance, I have also had to deal with our relationship issues/differences in this whole matter, my daughters relationship with him too – its totally so unfair and incomprehensible this burden has been blundered onto me!

As late as Friday (24th July) I learnt from the Department of Public Prosecutors of the severity of and the number of criminal charges and the number of offences committed, not only for my daughter but other daughters! – it sickened me to the core – totally gut wrenching – it makes me sick!.....it asks the questions – how many more will come forward!

I have and still seeing my Clinical Psychologist, and demand ongoing support from the ADF/AAFC as a minimum. Although the trial is set for September, I have discussed with my Psychologist my own mental well-being post trial as well – the trial is not a life switch that you simple turn off when its all over!

I convey these facts to you for consideration to extend ongoing support for psychological treatment.
