Sir,

I refer to my correspondence dated 22nd May 2015 regarding my withdrawal of the psychological support offered by the Royal Australian Air Force.

However, as the court matter of the DPP v ADAMS is soon to commence on the 21st September 2015, I'm starting to feel some form of anxiety. This anxiety, has made feel on edge about the uncertain outcome of the court hearing and the affect it will have on my daughter ^{CJE}. This anxiety was more noticeable last year with an increase of my alcohol intake which I got under control earlier this year. However, prior to my last letter I was prescribed medication to help with my difficulty in falling asleep.

Over the last few weeks, I'm finding it hard not to think about the trial and the intensive questioning and embarrassment that ^{CJE} will experience.

Therefore, I am asking that the RAAF reconsider funding access for me to seek psychological support for a period of up to and after the finalisation of the trial.

If approval is given, I would seek to counselling from REDACTED

Once again, I appreciate the psychological support the RAAF has provided ^{CJE} as she still has several issues that need to be dealt with. However, it would be good if the RAAF could correspond with her and show the RAAF is showing some form of support apart from psychological, you only have to review ^{CJE}'s record. She is and was a very dedicated member to the RAAF – Cadets.

I find it very depressing that we find ^{CJE} ending her time with the cadets on this type of situation.
