Dear Sean Watson,

First of all, I can not believe that ADF could do this and release this "Hot Issue" attached. I request this to be withdrawn immediately.

The release of this document has stirred the 'hornets' nest big time.

1. My daughter CJE – whilst at a AAFC Wing Function last weekend was shown this document and its content. CJE called me immediately, upset, socked and sent it through to me immediately.
2. The content identifies AAFC Course January 2013 in Wagga Wagga, for which CJE was at, and this also identifies other potential female victims.

I also need to ask a question hope that you will answer them.

- a. Has NSW Department of Community Services (DOCS) been formerly notified (Mandatory Reporting) of the alleged incident January 2013 at Wagga Wagga RAAF Base? If not – why not? If Yes – who to and when?
- b. What if any Supervision is in place for the Offender LAC Christopher ADAMS in the Northern Territory. I am gravely concerned of the more vulnerable community of such a small town if the offender re-offends?

I believe Sean Watson is on leave and there is no one else managing this matter in your absence, so I hope this finds you or your replacement as a matter of urgency.
