Wayne,

As I stated yesterday, myself and several of my colleagues, including the Crime Manager have discussed the matters that you reported to Sergeant McWhirter at Auburn Police Station in relation to LAC(AAFC) Christopher ADAMS.

Whilst the allegations that you have reported are serious, it is the position that Police attached to the Wagga Wagga Local Area Command will not be conducting any further investigation until the alleged victims themselves have made a formal complaint to Police.

Upon the receipt of any complaints from these victims, an assessment will then be made as to what action will be taken.

I have spoken personally to CJO who is the mother of CJE and advised her accordingly.

Given that the Australian Air Force Cadets have conducted some inquiries and spoken to a number of the affected parties and their parents, Police are seeking your assistance in informing those parties of the requirements of making a formal complaint.

If you, or any other the affected parties require any further information, please don't hesitate to contact myself or Detective Sergeant HANDLEY and BURNS at the Wagga Wagga Police Station.
