

Young army men guilty of assault

FOUR army apprentices were yesterday found guilty of assaulting a junior apprentice at the Balcombe army school, near Melbourne.

The youths, whose names have not been released, were sentenced to seven days' detention and fined \$40 over an incident in which apprentice

REDACTED, 18, of Western Australia, received a broken nose and facial injuries on Monday night.

But their commanding officer, Lieutenant Colonel A. M. McDonald, would not say last night if the youths had been recommended for discharge.
