Detention for trainees

MELBOURNE, Thursday. — Four Army apprentices were found guilty today of punching a junior apprentice, REDACTED, 18, at the Balcombe camp, 35 miles south-east of Melbourne, on Monday night.

Each was sentenced to seven days' detention and fined \$40.

A fifth apprentice was found guilty of failing to report "an act of bullying" and sentenced to 14 days' confinement to barracks.
