Eminence,

I refer to your record of a decision of March 18, 2006 Prot: N.32108/01CA, which has been conveyed to me by the Chancellor of my diocese.

I await the judgement of the Tribunal.

At this point I would like to point out that because of your record of decision and the efforts of my Ordinary, it has been impossible for me to continue my priestly work in the United States and my address is now as above.

I would also like to point out that in order to have gainful employment, I applied for and was granted (on June 9, 2006) a Bus Public Vehicle Driver Authority by the Ministry of Transport of the state of New South Wales. A copy of the authority is enclosed.

This Authority is only issued after a check has been made of the suitability of applicants, inter alia, to work with children. Thus the issuing of the Authority indicates that the civil authorities are satisfied that I present no danger to minors.

I make this point because it would be an embarrassment for the Church if your judgement indicated that there was some doubt in this regard.
