I am wrighting this letter in the hope that you might consider changing your mind about handing my uncle, [REDACTED], from visiting me and my brothers at the homes we live at.

To my knowledge my uncle only asked to have the pressure taken of him from seeing my two brothers, for the good of my brother my uncle and myself I ask you this too. My reason for this I will place down in a few facts of the past.

Fact one is that since 1967 when we were made a ward of the state of Victoria, my twin brother and myself have attended 19 schools, in Victoria and also eight of them in N.S.W.

Fact two is at the age of eight my twin and I have been submitted to live in a condemn house under the charge of foster parents, whom I find where unfit even to take care of there own three younger children. To that we were belted, staved, punished, made to bath only once a fortnight in a cold water bath. Apart from this we were sent carrying our school books to from school unused and with hardly a lunch between us.

Fact three is that on being sent to New Zealand relatives, I find

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this a large mistake because, we had just lost our lovely mother and were sent to relatives who could not give us the love we desperately needed as our ~~uncle~~ had a broken heart and our uncle had his hands filled with looking after his own two sons and his work. It was lucky that I left when I did, but my brothers were put to witness a mother's death of a relative, then to see our uncle run around with married women.

Fact four is what I have had to witness here at present, but I have also been told I live in the past.

From this letter you may yourself think so, but the reason I write down these few facts which have many more, is that you in the position yourself can see my brothers now need all the help they can get in helping them with their grades in school and also the companionship of some to take their father's place, whom they were closely attached to, **REDACTED** can do this. This letter I have placed down some of the past then if you decide that the past is not as it like **BHO**

REDACTED has told me, then why on earth did you go into the past with my uncle

REDACTED what he did then has nothing to do with what he wants for his ~~brothers~~ children.

My brother **REDACTED** said he did not want to see my uncle again.

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this is only I am sure, because I know my twin brother, because he did not want to admit he needed help from him, also I think someone is talking ^{him} about of seeing [REDACTED] You can surely see he needs more help than ever now, he most probably said he did not want to see [REDACTED] again to avoid a rather wet down.

My uncle's past has nothing to do with us but if people bring up some of his past just remember I have ~~a~~ had a past which is concerning the welfare department which would not look good I talked to someone who does not like this sort of treatment. Do not take this as a threat please just a reminder I am sure you can see my point My brothers and I need the love of my uncle even if it is only until February,

I must go now I will not show this letter anyone is right they may not allow me to send it to you.

You must pardon my bad mistakes and writing but that is a trace left from a bad past. Your
