I called out to Bayswater Boys Home today in order to interview three boys and discuss them with Brigadier Wright and the school teachers.

During the course of my interview with [REDACTED], he mentioned that he was concerned about an officer, Mr. [REDACTED] who tended to treat the boys roughly and be very stern and strict with them. As I had thought that Mr. [REDACTED] had left Bayswater, I questioned [REDACTED] further. He assured me that this officer was still there, and still indulging in such practices as hitting boys about the head, and kicking them in the rear. [REDACTED] felt that he was particularly severe in his treatment of the boys.
