The application from Col. Dale originally cited the name of the institution as "The Salvation Army Farm and Vocational Training Centre". This name applies to the whole establishment at Bayswater which comprises three "homes". No's 1 and 3 homes are now combined and regarded as the juvenile school where delinquent lads over 14 years are accommodated.

No. 2 home accommodates the school boys under 14 years and it was therefore felt that the term "farm and vocational training centre" was inappropriate when applied to this particular home.

Protracted negotiations with the Salvation Army authorities have taken place over many months during which period discussion was suspended on account of Col. Dale being away from Australia. He has now returned and finally agreement has been reached between him and the Department in naming the No. 2 part of the institution as "The Salvation Army Boys' Home (No.2.) Bayswater."
