With the erection of cottages at Box Hill Boys' Home it has been possible to place brothers and sisters together in the cottages. The remainder of the children from East Camberwell Children's Home will be accommodated at "Catherine Booth" Children's Home and "Kardinia." This allows us to withdraw from congregate care at 11 Brinsley Road, East Camberwell.

With these adjustments in child care, consideration has been given by the Salvation Army to a change of name for the Box Hill complex and this is now known as "Hayville." The Hospitals and Charities Commission has been advised of the change of name for registration purposes, and I would be grateful if this could be noted in your Department.

We have had a close liaison with the Children's Homes Section in all child placements from East Camberwell Children's Home.

If there are any further obligations with the Department I would appreciate it if I could be notified.
