Good Afternoon Ken,

Could you notify our insurers of a potential claim relating to the actions of a past teacher (Mr YJ) of which we have been keeping yourselves and our insurer fully informed since the incident first came to light in September 2009.

Mr YJ was found guilty in the District Court of 13 charges relating to indecent dealing with a children under 13 years of age. These incidents involve 5 separate complainants ranging from 21 years of age down to 11 years of age. The offending took place whilst each of the complainants were students in the teachers class. Mr YJ was remanded into custody for sentencing to take place on 3rd September (originally 27th August), at sentencing he received a 5 year jail term with eligibility for parole after serving 3 years.

Immediately after sentencing the Headmaster and Chair of Council met with the parents of the boys involved (4 families) and in some instances with the boys themselves being present. RED
