6.1 Headmaster's Report

Council received the Headmaster's Report for 27 October 2009.

Since I last formally reported to Council, the School has been dealing with the circumstances surrounding the dismissal and trial of Mr YJ. Mr YJ was a long standing member of the Preparatory School, employed over a period of 25 years. Since the first four charges were laid against Mr YJ for 'indecent dealings with a child under the age of 13' relating to a young Old Boy of the School a further fourteen charges have been presented to the Midland Magistrate's Court and these charges pertain to another four boys, two of whom are still currently enrolled in the Preparatory School. In total eighteen charges have now been laid and they pertain to 'indecent dealings' with a total of five past and current Preparatory School boys. Mr YJ will next appear before the Courts on the 27th November 2009. Depending on the nature of Mr YJ's plea, the police have informed us that this case may still be unresolved until late into 2010. As Fellows will appreciate, I

have spent considerable time dealing with the repercussions both within the School Staff as well as with the School families. The School Bursar has been a significant and supportive deputy in the process.
