- 1 She phoned about 8.30pm 25/05/00.
- 2 Paedophiles are drawn to teaching. Always a risk. They go where there are kids; not just BGS.
- 3 She comes from a Grammar family. Father/father's brother. Her (2?) boys.
- 4 She was horrified when first boy came for counselling. Then a second. Then a third (a brother of first or second). Two others came but did not return for counselling.
- 5 She then put it to her eldest son, who said "we all knew". She asked him why he didn't say something. He said, "You don't, do you?" Nutting's comment was that kids don't talk because of the shame. They keep it to themselves. No one talks. It goes underground. So Nutting says she is not surprised the School didn't know.
- 6 One of her clients tipped Rory Callinan off.
- 7 She is interested in opening it up. The more aware, the more help they will get. Not just for BGS. We know so much about it now (as a problem) ???? can get through it. Take the sting out of it.
- 8 All told her the same story. Relaxation class. Masturbation class. A lot suffering silently. Deal with it. REDACTED
- 9 What can we do? Teach our children to talk about it. Get it out in the open. Very shaming for boys when it happens. New professionally but now a leap in understanding.
- 10 The three she consulted to are through it. Happy lives at the moment. Laugh at it. They don't want to be named. Professionals. They were going wrong (though). One says molested while hypnotised. No sodomy.
