- The need for protective behaviours to be introduced into the P.D. Curriculum, particularly relating to sexual abuse.
- School to be alerted to the effect on any student at school who may have been abused, particularly the link between abuse and Nigel Parodi's behaviour. These students may now be reluctant to come forward.
- The importance of discussing these issues at school and at home.
- The need to publicise the relevant personnel to contact should students have concerns.
