Dear Mr. Howell,

Further to our conversation of last month regarding the salary payable to a Student Counsellor at B.G.S. I enclose as requested a copy of the allowances paid within the State Service.

These allowances are paid in respect of the duties undertaken by State Guidance Officers in relation to academic, vocational and personal counselling of students.

I further ask that you might favourably consider the payment of the allowance relating to a second degree since, examination being successful, I shall have gained 120 points of credit by the end of this year. These are the points which are necessary for a second degree (Arts for example) for a graduate in education. (B.Ed.)

By June 1977 when the Dip. School Counselling will be conferred I will have gained 155 points, that is 35 in excess of those required for a second degree.
