Dear Mr Howell,

In view of the State Cabinet decision of Monday 21 November 1988 to approve the terms of the amended superannuation scheme for B.G.S., I write to formally ask that you would request the Board of Trustees of Brisbane Grammar School to allow me early retirement as of 31 December 1988.

This request is painful to me, but must be made, as the only solution to financial difficulties consequent upon a failed marriage of June, 1985.

At 56 years of age I can do nothing but make the best provisions I may for what is, at present, a bleak and uninviting old age.

In view of the lateness of this request, which of course I regret, I make it clear to you, and the Trustees of Brisbane Grammar School, that should there be any difficulty in quickly finding another Student Counsellor for B.G.S., I will be more than willing, at no charge whatsoever to the school, to return in 1989 until the matter is satisfactorily resolved.
