**ELLIS v HIS EMINENCE CARDINAL PELL & THE TRUSTEES OF THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH FOR THE ARCHDIOCESE OF SYDNEY & ANOR

We refer to your facsimile dated 28 May 2008.

We note that your clients have resolved to 'defer' the recovery of their costs against our client. However, you do not indicate when such recovery has been deferred to. Could you please indicate when your clients intend to proceed with this matter.

In this regard, we note that your letter refers to the report of Dr Funnell of 23 April 2008. Our understanding of the tenor of the report was that Dr Funnell considered it detrimental to our client's wellbeing to have the issue of costs 'hanging over' him. However, this appears to be precisely what your letter achieves, by affirming your client's intention to pursue their costs at some unspecified future date.

In light of this, we request your prompt response to our request to clarify the timing of the proposed further recovery action.

We also request that you provide to us a copy of Dr Funnell's letter.

In relation to our letter of 16 May 2008, we advise that our client's wife's father has recently loaned her funds to clear a substantial portion of her credit card debt. This made up the majority of the credit card debt referred to in our letter.
