Dear Marita, Michael and father John

After several weeks of correspondence, Mr Ellis and his solicitor Mr Begg have now accepted that the *Ellis* Supreme Court proceedings were dismissed by the judgment of the Court of Appeal on 24 May 2007. This obviates the need for any further court hearings.

The only outstanding matter is the manner in which we deal with Mr Ellis' costs debt.

In light of the Cardinal's instructions, I intend to draft a short letter which states that in light of Mr Ellis' health and financial situation, the defendant's will not be pursuing their costs at this stage.

I will have a draft to you for your instructions in the next few days.
