SAFETY, REHABILITATION & COMPENSATION ACT 1988 (SRCA)

I refer to your claim for compensation for a "anxiety, depression, IBS and peripheral neuropathy" condition. I have considered it carefully, however the evidence has failed to establish that there is liability to pay compensation.

For a claim to be successful under the Act, the evidence has to show that it is probable, and not merely possible, that your military service was a contributing factor to the causation, aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of the disease.

DECISION

I determine that the claim is disallowed.

In making my decision I referred to the report from Defence Personnel Records which states that there are "no incident reports or medical documents to substantiate his claim".

Enclosed is a brochure which explains your rights under the Act. Please read it carefully.
