The Sano Taskforce was established to investigate allegations emanating from the Victorian Parliamentary Inquiry into child sex abuse involving Religious and Non-Government organizations.

Based within Victoria Police's crime command, Sano is comprised of specialist sexual assault detectives who utilize modern methods to identify links between offenders and offences.

The taskforce now coordinates investigations stemming from the Australian Government Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse.
