Dear Jonathan,

I have been in receipt of some express concerns from your current housemaster colleagues about some matters arising from your establishment of a base in **RED**. Perhaps they all revolve around the question of whether you are really living on campus or off it. What Conditions of Service say, of course, is that a member of staff "must not, without the consent of Council, reside elsewhere than in the accommodation provided at school".

The concerns have taken the following form:

1. that any approval for pupils to visit **REDA** should be established by direct contact between you and the housemaster in question
2. that permission should not be granted to visits to **RED ACT** unless you yourself are personally present and able to ensure that all is well
3. that the residence in Biddlecombe Avenue should not be visited for any purpose in your absence.

What all these matters suggest to me is that we do need to consider more carefully the question of just where you are residing.
