I thank you for your prompt reply to my letter of 14 November and also for the sentiment contained therein.

Following your recommendation I awaited a response from the principal and regret to report that he appears to have neither the grasp nor feel for the topic.

I reiterate I have concerns about a priest who was at Timbertop when I was there and about the abuse I suffered.

I had hoped to deal with the matter in direct discussion with the school rather than have to resort to a campaign via Facebook, advertisements in the Age calling for other abused to step forward and making a submission to the Inquiry into the Handling of Child Abuse by Religious and Other Organisations. Instead, I get the direct impression the principal wants to fob me off.

Please identify an alternative to the principal as a person to whom I can lodge my complaint. Please indicate, also, the processes the school has put in place to address such issues.
