My full name is Robert John BUGG. I am 65 years old. My address is known to Police, I do not wish my details to be given out without my consent.


Between May 1981 and June 1993 I was the Master of the Geelong Grammar School Highton Campus situated in Pigeons Road Waurin Ponds. My role was essentially of being in charge entire the campus.

I in turn reported to John LEWIS who was the Senior School Head Master. My deputy Master from around 1988 to 1993 was Paul CLARIDGE and there was three Boarding Masters, Roger MORTON, Christopher NOBLE and Tony INKSTER.

Then there were a number of Student assistants who worked in the boarding house. This position was primarily aimed at students from Deakin University. They were given a flat which was in the boarding house itself, food and a small fee. Their role was supporting the children in the Boarding house and to assist getting them up in the morning, showered breakfast and off to school. Then on return from school to help assist with the afternoon routine of homework, dinner and the general running of the boarding house.

Philippe TRUTMANN was employed in this role from around the mid to late 1980's and was still there when I left in 1993.

Philippe would always go beyond his job description and the whole time I was there I never heard bad report about Philippe that I recall. The campus was like a big family and Philippe fitted in to that.
