Dear Mr Farmer,

Re: Dr John Rolleston (MPO 085512)

I refer to our telephone discussion this instant.

Advice is sought as to the merits of filing a Complaint against the abovenamed medical practitioner in the Medical Tribunal.

I enclose a Brief of Evidence provided by the Investigations Division who initiated the request. A summary of the evidence is incorporated in the Investigations Report, which I do not propose to repeat.

Briefly, two male complainants allege that Dr Rolleston sexually assaulted them during patient consultations in the 1970s when both men were in their early teens. Complainant 1 alleges masturbation by Dr Rolleston on three occasions. Complainant 2 has raised allegations of masturbation and self-masturbation at the direction of Dr Rolleston, as well as anal digital penetration by him on one occasion. Both complainants have alleged serious long-term psychological suffering as a result of the alleged abuse. These complaints were raised with the HCCC in 2006.

Complainant 1 initially raised his complaint with the HCCC in 2003, however, due to his failure to provide further requested information, the investigation was discontinued. Complainant 1 has since provided reasons for his re-agitation of the complaint.


Dr Rolleston, through United Medical Protection, has strenuously denied the allegations. He denies possession of any relevant clinical records and denies having an independent memory of the complainants. His legal representatives assert that their client will be unfairly prejudiced in the event of any future prosecution, on account of the delay in the complaints and his asserted inability to defend the allegations.

I look forward to discussing the matter with you once you have had the opportunity to peruse the material.

I require the advice by **18 June 2007**, if possible.
