- 4/7/79 - [illegible] hospital
- was in year 8 or 9 at school
- I was 15 yr old at the time

- [illegible] grass playground with metal square covering the electricity supply.
- Fell over [illegible] coccyx bone – felt immediate pain, could barely walk
- After school – we played
- I rang my grandmother, REDACTE with whom I was living (for a couple months). She picked me up and drove me straight to RNSH. Went straight into casualty – we were told to wait for a while (about 4-4:30) it was still light

Nurse called you in

“come through”

- My grandmother and I both got up to go through
- [illegible] [illegible] [illegible] [illegible] – through revolving doors into a large area with a number of beds with curtains.

- Saw a man standing - was about 45-50 yes of age, white coat, light browny fair hair, fair complexion, about 5’11 to 6 ft tall, medium build.

- Nurse led us up to the doctor and handed him my card [illegible] and then she left.
- He said to my grandmother

“He’ll be fine. If you just want to wait. He won’t be long”

- My grandmother then went out into the waiting room
- He then showed me into a very small office off the room. The door was shut. Was a push button lock I believe.
- Two chairs and an examination bench
- He sat in one chair, I sat in another
- He was still at the door when I said down
- He said “what seems to be the problem”

I – “I hurt the bone at the bottom of my back”

He – “your coccyx bone”

I - “Yeah”

He “How did you hurt it”

I – “I fell over in the playground at school, mucking around and fell on to a metal plate

He – “well hop up on the bench”

(I was wearing school shorts)

- I then got on the bench.
- He then said “lie down on your side. Take your pants down”
- I took my pants down a little bit and he then took them all the way off one leg.

[illegible] I was lying on – left left. He then took my under pants off with my help.

- He said “we have to check to see if you have blood in you semen & we have to see if you have blood in your semen + we have to see if you have blood in your anus”
- I said “ how can there be blood in my semen”
- He said “That’s very easy to happen. We don’t know until we check.”
- I felt alarmed at this stage

He put a glove on as he was saying this and so I felt this was a medical procedure.

- ~~Put gloves on both hands.~~
- He had a glove on one hand only. He started to stroke my dick until I got an erection – for a couple minutes. He then moved his other hand through between my legs and inserted his finger, he was moving his finger around [illegible]
- A couple of minutes more this continued with both masturbation and in my anus.
- He then stopped masturbating me and told me to masturbate myself – He withdrew his finger from my anus. He then put [illegible] glove. Then he put his finger into my anus and he was moving his finger around in my anus and said

“tell me when you are going to cum.”
- He had his [illegible] gloved hand position [illegible] collect the sperm

he said "just get dressed"

As soon as I ejaculated he went straight to a sink and cleaned up. He took his glove off and said,

"No [illegible] no blood in your semen and no blood in your anus. That's the most important thing. You're fine. Just rest. "

He then opened the door and I left

- I felt very upset when I was walking towards my grandmother
- I left still very uncertain whether anything inappropriate had occurred.

Grandmother said: " what happened what did he say"

- I grew up in Manly– I was awake to it
- Spent all my time at the beach. Phillip Bell we used him
- I was watching all the stories on Phillip Bell.
- Mid – 1997 – started to grow in me.
- I shouted it out.

- Dr Malcolm Parmenter at 393 medical centre at Mosman
- It was on myplate so much – I could not stop thinking about it.
- I told Dr Malcolm – he said that’s not any way to examine – you have 100% been sexually abused.
- It was affecting my relationship w/ my girlfriend.

I told my girlfriend

She spun out [illegible] left [illegible] [illegible]

- I wrote [illegible] letter out and didn’t send it.
- Went to see Malcolm and he prescribed Prothiaden to me –
- I went and saw a psychiatrist and psychologist to [illegible] treatment for my anxiety.
- It is understandable
- I’ve now told my girlfriend, [illegible]
- Still haven’t told my best friend b/c [illegible] we were all homophobic.
- Anxiety - [illegible] - sweat , freak out

Psychiatrist. Dr Lampe Didn't tell her about [illegible] [illegible] anxiety


Psychologist. Simonette Gow – Told her
