

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT
OF THE NORTH COAST CHILDREN'S HOME HELD AT THE HOME ON 31 MAY
1985 AT 7.30P.M.

PRESENT: Rev. G. Foley in the Chair. Messrs Heap, Hepburn, Thomas, Riley, Ward and Morton.

SPECIAL BUSINESS: The Secretary reported that [REDACTED] the Superintendent had been charged on two counts of assault one alleging actual bodily harm and he had been remanded to appear before the Local Court at Lismore on 17 June. The Secretary reported that the Executive had met on the day the charges were laid and that [REDACTED] had been suspended on full salary pending the outcome of the proceedings. He was permitted to continue to occupy the cottage but was to have no contact with any of the children in the Home. Mr Gary Corben had been appointed acting Superintendent in place of [REDACTED] and his wages have been adjusted accordingly.

It was resolved that the action of the Executive in suspending [REDACTED] on the forgoing conditions be confirmed and that Mr Gary Corben be confirmed in his position as acting Superintendent.

STAFF MEETING: Four members of the staff were invited to join the meeting and all expressed support for [REDACTED]. The staff were informed of the action taken and it was resolved that a new male member of the staff should be appointed following the Committee's previous resolution and that steps should be taken to appoint a part-time Co-Ordinator.

THERE BEING no further business the meeting was closed at 9p.m.
