I employed Craig Patterson as a teacher of English and Drama at St Paul's School from January 1988, until he resigned of his own volition at the end of the 1999 School year.

During his time at St Paul's Mr Patterson taught English throughout the Secondary School, and accepted a leading position in the teaching of Drama, the other subject taught within the English Department.
