It has been brought to my attention that some people believe I am supporting my brother Grant. Let me be clear I am not, RG Dance is not.

My brother's behaviour has and does disgust me.

If you were present at the parents meeting we held at the studio on 21 May you would have heard me say it was BZB and I who took the material to the police, it is inconceivable that I would support Grant. To me Grant is gone. I will have nothing further to do with him.

If you were at the meeting of parents which was attended by Police Superintendent Jones, Police Inspector Pryde and a community police officer, you would have heard Superintendent Jones say that "RG Dance is a safe environment and there is no threat to the children, if I thought there was he would have closed us down".

It is worth noting the police examined the whole studios and nothing was found to suggest any criminal or immoral behaviour had occurred there.

I wish to be very blunt when I say this. I have no love or support for my brother. I will not be supporting him in any way, financially or emotionally. I am as disgusted as the rest of you.
