

In light of the non-communication, either verbal or written, regarding the outcome of recent investigations, (conducted 28 May) which you yourself instigated in the interests of public safety, and to establish if there was any dereliction of duty on my part with view to disciplinary action, I am seeking your immediate response.

I was disgusted by the off-hand comment by an Executive Manager earlier this week. While granting approval for me to purchase one length of sewer pipe for the septic tank, 2 kgs of pool chlorine for the water tank, mentioned, between the sewer pipe and the chlorine, "Oh, by the way, I suppose you have heard that the Council has decided to sell Natural Springs Camp?" This just happens to be my home and livelihood.

I still have not been told of any change in the Management structure of Camp Sites or to whom I am responsible, and the lack of professional courtesy astounds me from an organisation that purports to care for people.

As you personally wrote to me concerning the then impending serious investigation, I expect no less than a letter from you informing me of the outcome, the future of this camp and my employment status.
