- 1) Very cold and miserable - only form of heating is open fire needs to chainsaw over $\frac{1}{2}$ ton wood for 4 to 5 days. Used 11 tons last winter - running out of wood.
- 2) Says has been promised a heater for some time. Has gas connected would like a space heater. Says it is about 8% inside. A new heater installed would cost \$600 + I we sell & he bought would take the \$600 into account as extra.
- 3) Wants to talk to me urgently - to discuss
 - a) his ostriches - their long term abode and future
 - b) Job employment - his words not mine - how much longer.
 - c) Log of claims against ACS - he says he has given much more than he should have.
- 4) I made appointment for 10 am at Harrigate on Tuesday 22-7-97
- 5) He says in respect to his log of claims, we have people in ACS well versed in what has happened in similar cases in the industrial courts. He is implying that he will do well. However he says that he won't put it in writing at this stage as he hopes to settle without going to court.
