File Notes of Phone Call from Bob McLennan 25/8/97  
1-15 pm

Bob McLennan rang me and said that he was reporting the latest development. He had received an unexpected visit from two Mt Barker Council employees at Harrogate Camp - the Building Inspector and the Health Inspector.

He went to pains to stress that it was a routine inspection and had not been instigated by himself. I thought this was most strange seeing that it coincided with the time after we had closed Harrogate as a campsite.

I asked Bob what they had come to examine, and he informed me that it was

- the camp site buildings
- the septic system
- the water supply
- the drainage
- the house and its septic system

He said they were there about two hours and asked questions of a practical nature relating to buildings, water supply, electrical generation, i.e. in relation to what they saw. He claims he told them that he had been instructed not to use the 240 volt power and it had been dismantled so that it could not be.

He said they asked him if he intended living there to which he replied that he had been given notice to vacate by 22/10/97.

He said he had given my name to them and that they would be preparing a report and contacting ACS re their findings.
