do solemnly and sincerely declare
that,

I was employed as full time Administration Assistant at Gold Coast Family Support Group Inc., from 9th January 1995 to 14th February 1997.

Although I do not recall the exact date, I clearly remember being informed of a complaint of a sexual nature being made against a male support worker. Mrs Dorothy Williams, the Manager of Gold Coast Family Support Group, informed me that Mrs Maree Welch had made a complaint about a male support worker assigned to care for her daughter, Bobbie Welch.

Mrs Maree Welch, also a part-time employee of the organisation at that time, made the allegation after her daughter, a client of GCFSG, told her mother of the alleged incident.

I recall that Mrs Williams told me she had telephoned interstate to speak with the worker's previous employer. This call was made after the alleged incident.

And I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of the provisions of the Oaths Act 1867
