Dear Lloyd,

Further to our discussion with you last night regarding our Letter of Grievances dated 14th October, we request that you submit this letter to the Committee of the Gold Coast Family Support Group this week.

I stand by what I reported to Ms. M. Edwards on 10th April, 1995. (approx. 5.00 p.m) i.e. I think Bobbie has been interfered with, sexually molested or possibly raped. It was our intention to report this matter ourselves to the police that week but our opportunity to do so was jeopardised by the matter being mentioned to the suspected support worker by staff of F.S.G. We were still endeavouring to gain further details from our child who, as you know, has limited communication skills.

We did not become aware until the 26th March, 1998 that no reports of this incident had been made at the time of the initial complaint, and neither had the incident been reported to the President and Committee.

It is the responsibility of F.S.G. to place on record a true and concise report of such complaint. It is 8 months since I originally requested a copy of the FSG Reports.

As we have not yet received answers to our queries in our letter dated 28th September, 1998 (submitted to you at the FSG Annual General Meeting), it appears we will have to seek further advice regarding this matter.
