CURRICULUM VITAE

I am self-employed as a Canon Law adviser and consultant to diocesan bishops, diocesan agencies, parishes, religious institutes and other Catholic Church organisations and individuals. I am an Advocate for the Ecclesiastical Regional Tribunal of Sydney of the Catholic Church.

I obtained a Licentiate in Theology [STL] from the Ecclesiastical Faculty of Sydney in 1967. I obtained a Doctorate in Canon Law from the Pontifical Urban University, Rome in 1972.

I was a lecturer in canon law at the Catholic Theological Institutes in Sydney between 1972 and 1996. I was a judge of the Ecclesiastical Regional Tribunal of Sydney 1979-2004 and of the Tribunal of Appeal for Australia and New Zealand 1981-2004.

I was ordained a priest in 1967 and obtained a dispensation from all obligations arising from ordination in 2004. I held various ecclesiastical offices relating to diocesan governance in the Diocese of Wollongong and the Archdiocese of Sydney between 1972 and 1989. I was Assistant Secretary to the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference in Canberra 1989-1991.
