Frank O'Loughlin S.T.D. was born in 1945 and was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Melbourne, Australia in 1969.

He gained a Doctorate in Theology at the Urban University, Rome in 1975 and did Studies at the Irish Institute of Pastoral Liturgy in 1976-7.

He lectured in Fundamental and Sacramental Theology at Catholic Theological College, Melbourne, Australia from 1977 to 1996 and was Director of the Diocesan Liturgy Centre from 1977 to 1994.

He was involved in the formation of candidates for the priesthood from 1977 to 1990 at Corpus Christi College, Clayton.

He is currently Parish Priest of Sandringham in the Archdiocese of Melbourne.
