Dear Dr Rentoul


Thank you for your letter dated the 8<sup>th</sup> January 2010. I would firstly like to acknowledge and express my genuine concern for you and your family as you manage this stressful and extremely sensitive issue.

Messrs Stewart and Nisbett were not mentioned in my correspondence of 16<sup>th</sup> December 2009 because their cases have yet to appear before the Court. Further, the School does not wish to jeopardise proceedings in anyway. For information relating to the progress status of proceedings against Messrs Stewart and Nisbett, may I suggest that you contact Hornsby Police Station, 9476 9707 and speak to Detective Rebecca Dummett. You will understand that the School cannot be the source of such information.

The School does not, and will not, know the names of all the victims of those who have already pleaded guilty, but, in all cases where a guilty plea is entered, or the person charged is proven guilty, if an Old Boy of the School would like to receive a written letter of apology the School and the Uniting Church in Australia will certainly ensure that this is undertaken. The Police are able to assist the School and the Old Boy in this regard.
