## DR JOHN ROLLESTON

Dr Rolleston has been subject to two complaints. One made in December 1998, which was referred to investigation but then *no further action* in November 2001, and another in June 2003, in which the complainant alleged that Dr Rolleston sexually assaulted him and his brother and an un-identified female sibling during the 1970s while patients at Dr Rolleston's St Ives practice.

It was determined at Conduct Sub-Committee meeting on 9 December 2003, to take no further action on this latter complaint as the complainant was unwilling to provide a statutory declaration. It was discovered that Dr Rolleston is the proposed supervisor for area of need practitioners and that being the subject of complaints, may make him unsuitable as a supervisor. As the complaint by Mr AWH has now been terminated, Dr Rolleston is not prevented from being an area of need practitioner supervisor.

Bhavana has looked at the policy in relation to supervisors and complaints and has incorporated the policy into area of need supervisor approval processes.
