I think not. I will need to track through this in more detail but I was acting on instructions from Ted Exell, all of the instructing correspondence is to and from him.

Looking specifically at the defences, I liaised with Ted Exell on 5 May 2004 regarding the content and then forwarded the filed copies to him on 7 May 2004.

Apart from an email at the very start of the file where I emailed Michael Casey to let him know that Cardinal Pell is not a defendant, there is no correspondence or file notes with the Sydney Archdiocese on the files.

Note that these issues have escalated today with the revelation by the Fosters that Emma was paid \$450,000. This will all need further discussion once the next few days are behind us.
