S VIC 263 - ROYAL COMMISSION INTO INSTITUTIONAL RESPONSES TO CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE - SUMMONS TO PRODUCE

As per the Royal Commission into institutional responses to child sexual abuse summons to produce dated 8 February 2016, Netball Australia provides the following documents:

1. All current policies, procedures and/or guidelines maintained and/or applied by Netball Australia Limited, or its member organisations in relation to:
 - (a) The prevention of child sexual abuse, including screening of volunteers and employees;
 - (b) The receiving and/or handling of complaints of child sexual abuse;
 - (c) Internal investigations of complaints of child sexual abuse
 - (d) Reporting complaints of child sexual abuse to public agencies;
 - (e) The dissemination of information between member organisations (including amateur netball clubs) concerning allegations, charges and/or convictions relating to child sexual abuse; and
 - (f) Record keeping practices (including what records are made, with what details, who has access to these and for how long are they retained).
2. Any legal advice received by Netball Australia Limited in relation to the development of its Member Protection Policy.
