We refer to previous communications regarding this matter. In accordance with your advices, our client attended Ashfield Police Station on 30 instant to collect the property seized pursuant to search warrants executed at his home and business premises on 14 May 2007.

We advise that the property listed hereunder has not been returned to our client:

1. Black Nokia Phone (Item #1 on Property Seizure Form #A78016);
2. Silver Nokia Phone (Item #2 on Property Seizure Form #A78016);
3. Sandisc Memory Card (Item #5 on Property Seizure Form #A78016);
4. Silver Apple Mac Laptop Computer (Item #6 on Property Seizure Form #A78016);
5. Motorola VGA Phone (Item #13 on Property Seizure Form #A78016);
6. Book named "Think Like A Champion, Dance Like A Star" (Item #4 on Property Seizure Form #A78018);

There is no current Order pursuant to the *Commonwealth Crimes Act, 1914* and, in particular, after the Application made by you on 16 May 2007 for an extension of the period of 72 hours to examine the items was extended to 9:30am on 30 May 2007, you have not made any further application to extend the period. Accordingly, your continued detention of the above listed items is unlawful.

If the above listed items are not returned to our client within 48 hours of the receipt of this letter by you, we will seek instructions to commence court proceedings against NSW Police for an Order for return of this property, together with necessary ancillary Orders and an Order for Costs of the proceeding.
